


AVAILABILITY - If you would like to see Fr Michael without having first made an appointment, he will next be available on <u>Monday between 5pm- 6pm</u>



Mary's Meals is a charity that feeds children one good meal every day in their place of education. The charity started in November 2002 feeding 200 children in Malawi; it now feeds over 2.27 million children every school day.

Mary's Meals will be speaking at all Masses this weekend. Bear in mind that because of some generous donors all donations given will be matched up to a limit of £1.5 million. £15.90 normally feeds a child one good meal every school day for a whole year, but with Mary's Meals 'Double the Love' campaign the same £15.90 donation will feed not 1 but 2 children for a whole school year! Please note there is not a collection of unwanted clothes – the Rags to Riches project has unfortunately ended. Mary's Meals relies on volunteers which means it can keep its costs very low. Simply choose the amount you wish to donate and hold your card onto the reader. You can also opt-in for Gift Aid to increase your donation by 25%. If you are a UK taxpayer then donating with Gift Aid means that we can claim an extra 25p for every £1 received. Contactless donations are simple to administer, secure and convenient.
