Please note: weekday mass will be in the side chapel during the cold weather.

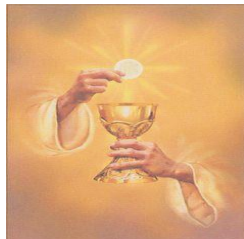


CONFIRMATION 2023
