



PLEASE DO NOT STAND IN FRONT OF IT AND BLOCK IT.

Just use your contactless debit/credit card or smart phone/ device to make a donation. Simply choose the amount you wish to donate and hold your card onto the reader. You can also opt-in for Gift Aid to increase your donation by 25%. If you are a UK taxpayer then donating with Gift Aid means that we can claim an extra 25p for every £1 received. Contactless donations are simple to administer, secure and convenient.

Please note – <u>for all donations to the parish!</u> If you are no longer paying tax, please let the parish office know as soon as possible.
