Dear Parishioners,

"He who exalts himself will be humbled, he who humbles himself will be exalted"

This Sunday the Gospel reading tells us about Jesus being invited to a meal at the house of one of the Pharisees. Jesus uses the opportunity to focus on the theme of humility. To be humble, according to Jesus, is to not exalt or think too highly of our self. Rather, the humble person chooses 'the lowest place at the table'. That person chooses not to pursue their own status but to prioritise the needs and the presence of others. We are told that, for this act of sacrifice, God will reward the humble person in the end: "For every one who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted." The best example of this is Jesus himself. Though he is the Son of God, Jesus allows himself to be considered even less than nobody. However, Jesus knows who he is in God's eyes and he also shows us our true worth when he offers his life on the cross for us. Grateful for this amazing gift from God the Christian person is then called to serve others, not expecting to be served in return or showered with immediate rewards or acclaim. From Jesus, we learn to love others whether or not they love us back. One of the best ways to live out humility, according to Jesus, is to care for "the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind." It takes true humility to associate oneself with the downtrodden and outcasts of society, just as Jesus himself did. True humility involves going out of our way to interact with those most in need. Humility may well involve giving alms and contributing to charity, but even more it involves giving our very selves. Let us pray this week to understand the call to understand our lives in relation to the needs of others and for the gift of the necessary humility to serve Christ in our neighbour.
