+FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Dear Parishioners

'Stay awake, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect...'

As we begin the season of Advent this Sunday, and we contemplate the future coming of the Son of God we can ask ourselves - are we awake spiritually speaking? The first coming of Jesus is principally what we will celebrate later at Christmas. The unity of human nature with divine nature, in the Person of Jesus, is truly awe-inspiring. The next coming of Jesus that we can reflect on daily, is his coming by grace, every moment and every day of our lives. As we increasingly develop this kind of spiritual awareness, we find a deeper perception of the countless opportunities to become more united to Jesus every day and to be used as an instrument of his grace. The alternative is to gradually become more and more drowsy, spiritually speaking, and eventually fall entirely asleep! A wonderful measure of our daily attentiveness to the innumerable gifts of grace given to us every day is to also consider how attentive we are to the final and glorious coming of Christ at the end of time. Just as Jesus explains, most people will pay little attention to this final coming, presuming it will either not be in their lifetimes or that it is simply a type of myth or legend. However, if we have that attitude, then we have completely missed the value of being spiritually prepared —today, tomorrow and always. True preparedness for the final coming of Christ will not only help us enter the mysteries of these Advent and Christmas seasons, it will also help us throughout all the events and story of our life. Whichever way Jesus comes to us, it is as our merciful Saviour who sacrificed himself on a Cross for our liberation from sin and eternal salvation. Advent is a time to renew our alertness to the wonderful gift that God offers us through Jesus in our lives. Let us reflect, today, upon how ready we are for all the ways that Jesus will come to us in this season, so that God may transform us in ways that are glorious beyond comprehension.
