SUNDAY 5TH MARCH 2023 +2ND SUNDAY OF LENT

Dear Parishioners,

'Jesus took Peter, James, and John his brother, and led them up a high mountain by themselves and he was transfigured before them.'

On this second Sunday of our Lenten preparation for the great feast of Easter, we are given the scene of the Transfiguration of Jesus to contemplate. Here the Son of God allowed His glory to shine forth as he conversed with Moses and Elijah in the presence of three of His disciples. Moses and Elijah, these two great Old Testament figures, now stand as witnesses of the final fulfilment of God's unfolding plan in Jesus. On the Mount of the Transfiguration, Jesus prepared the three disciples to continue the mission that began through Moses and continued through Elijah. Today, our Lord calls all of his faithful servants up a spiritual mountain with him to entrust to us the ongoing mission given to these faithful servants in the past. Through prayer, God will manifest his divine presence to each of us if we are willing to make this journey with him. Following the gloriously transfigured face of Jesus on Mount Tabor, the disciples then had to confront the hideously disfigured face of the beautiful Saviour on the mountain of Calvary. But it was precisely through this great sacrifice of love, in the suffering, death and Easter resurrection of Jesus, that the great new covenant is made for us. Let us reflect, today, upon this glorious scene of the Transfiguration. This image teaches us about the entire plan of God throughout time. Let us prayerfully ponder that Jesus is inviting us to make the journey up the mountain of prayer, self-discipline, virtue and holiness with him. Let us pray that our eyes will be open to see the glory of Jesus and that this experience will inspire and strengthen us to continue to fulfil the mission that God started long ago, until it comes to its final completion when Jesus returns at the end of time.
