SUNDAY 26TH MARCH 2023 +5TH SUNDAY OF LENT

Dear Parishioners,

"Lazarus, come out!"

On this 5th Sunday of Lent, as we approach the great feast of Easter, we hear about the raising of Lazarus from his grave. This extraordinary and undeniable miracle shows us that Jesus truly is the Lord of Life. The Scriptures overall help us to understand that death and sin bare a relation. When evil was allowed to enter through the choices of our first parents, death also came into God's creation. At Easter we will be rejoicing that Jesus, by the gift of his life on the Cross and by his Resurrection, has abolished the hold that evil, sin and death have over us. The Church teaches us that the best way to rejoice fully in this gift is to complete our 'Easter duties' in this time of preparation. The death of Lazarus can be seen as symbolic of a soul that has died from sin. When Jesus cries "Lazarus, come out", Lazarus comes forth but is still bound 'hand and foot with burial bands.' We can see in this a symbol of the whole process of confession and the forgiveness of sins. Lazarus' obedience to the command of Jesus symbolises our response to God to 'come out' of the darkness of our sins. Then when Jesus says, "Untie him and let him go," this speaks to us of the power of the Sacrament of Confession to release us from our sins. Sin keeps us from experiencing already the gift of eternal salvation. This is remedied through Confession and forgiveness. When we sin, we also become attached to that sin and the ongoing temptation to return to it is strengthened. Our humble confession and reception of sacramental absolution strengthens us in the possibility of growing in holiness and virtue instead. Let us reflect today on the compassionate voice of Jesus who calls us to "Come out!" What sin is Jesus calling us to be free from? God desires that we be completely unbound and set free. Let us be open to that grace and do all we can to accept it.
