Dear Parishioners,

"Come to me, all you who labour and are over-burdened, and I will give you rest."

In this Sunday's Gospel reading, Jesus invites those 'who labour and are over-burdened' to come to him and to carry instead the light and easy yoke that he gives. Jesus is speaking in the context of those among the scribes and Pharisees who had so distorted the practice of the Jewish faith that it had become a burden that was too difficult to carry. In contrast, Jesus' new law of love is light, easy and liberating. When we consider Jesus' many teachings, do we see them as easy to follow? Or do they seem to be too much at times? Jesus himself says: 'my yoke is easy, and my burden light', so we can be certain that they must be possible. Jesus not only calls us to spiritual and moral perfection, but also gives us the means by which we can obtain it. By witnessing to a life of pure love to the point of sacrifice and then taking the burden of our weaknesses and sins on the Cross, Jesus opens up a new way for us of mercy and grace; to find our path through life and home to God. When we find some obligation in this life too difficult or even overwhelming, then it is an opportunity to rely upon the grace that God has given us through Jesus to fulfil his commands. Let us reflect, today, upon Jesus' gentle invitation to us to embrace the 'yoke' of his perfection. Let us see it as a joyous invitation from our Lord, through which God not only calls us to the heights of holiness, but also provides us with the means to obtain it. With faith in his almighty power and love we can open ourselves more fully so that we will be able to do anything and everything our Lord asks of us with freedom and joy.

The Parish was contacted this week by The Friends of Eastcote House Gardens and advised that their Community Shield this year has been awarded to the gardeners of our parish for their work in transforming the grounds of our estate into a pleasing visual display that benefits the whole of the local community.

Their committee considered several possible recipients and determined that St Thomas More Church grounds were of such attraction that passer-by paused to enjoy the view and take the opportunity to come in and explore further. It was considered such a meaningful asset that it merited this year's award of a shield (which we hold for the year) and certificate of excellence.
