Dear Parishioners,

This is the time of fulfilment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel.'

This Sunday we hear Jesus begin his public ministry immediately after being tempted by the devil in the desert. As Jesus begins his ministry, he declares: 'This is the time of fulfilment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel'. The beginning of Jesus' public ministry was, historically speaking, the time of fulfilment, because the new era of the Gospel of grace had begun. However, the 'time of fulfilment' is also each time we ourselves hear the Gospel and respond with our lives. This is done by repenting of our sins and becoming a more committed member of God's Kingdom. The word 'fulfilled' can be contrasted with its opposite 'unfulfilled.' When we find ourselves unfulfilled we often try to fill this void with so many things: power, pleasures, prestige, possessions... Our faith tells us however, that true fulfilment is only found in the Gospel, the message of truth that Jesus shared during his three years of public ministry and then brought to completion by his sacrificial death and resurrection. Only those who heed his words and open themselves to the grace poured forth from the Cross are able to find the fulfilment that they seek. This is because we are made in the image of God who is love. Only love will truly fulfil us and protect us from evil and fear. Let us reflect, today, upon our own interior desire for fulfilment in life. How do we try to fulfil this desire? Do we allow false solutions to our needs such as pride or wealth? Let us reject those temptations with our Lord and then immerse ourselves in his Gospel message, which is the only source of fulfilment in life.
