1. PLEASE USE **BLOCK CAPITALS** IN COMPLETING THE FORM.
2. The application **must be completed and signed by the Candidate – NOT BY A PARENT.**
3. Full participation in the preparation programme is expected. Poor attendance may result in deferral until a later year.
4. Completed forms can be delivered or sent to the Priests House, or handed in at Sunday Mass, in an envelope marked “Confirmation Application.”
5. A Baptismal Certificate must accompany this application if the Candidate was not baptised at St Philip’s, Finchley. The Certificate must show the name of the church of Baptism as well as a full postal address.
6. Candidates should be in their third year in secondary school (Year 9) or above.
7. Your decision to be confirmed must be yours, and yours alone. If you do not feel mature enough to make the decision, wait and decide another year.
8. Parental pressure does not allow for honest and mature decision making by the candidate.
9. Do not be pressurised into being confirmed because “it’s the age to do so!”
10. If you feel, at any stage in the course, that you are not ready to make the commitment, it shows greater maturity to leave the course and reconsider at another time.
11. By signing this form, you are giving your consent to having your photograph displayed in the church together with the other Confirmation candidates. You may withdraw that consent in a separate written request to the parish.
12. **Protecting your privacy** – Your personal details will be stored and used by the Parish for purposes of conducting and administering the Sacrament of Confirmation. By signing below, you acknowledge that Church Law requires some of your personal data to be entered in Registers and stored permanently; the Parish is obliged to notify the parish where you were baptised, if different. Data may also have to be shared with the Diocese of Westminster.
