A Letter From Our Parish Priest

Dear Parishioners,

We use the word 'love' in many different ways. Probably the most common usage is in the realm of romantic love, but that can often refer to a feeling that is self-centred, more focused on the pleasure of the lover than on the wellbeing of the beloved.

When Christ talks of love, he is referring to something at the other end of the spectrum. For Christ, love is about seeking the wellbeing of the beloved. He himself showed us a supreme example of that kind of love by willingly submitting himself to suffering and death in order to redeem us from our

Christ has given us a commandment to love one another as he has loved us. We may well wonder whether one can be commanded to love. Surely love is something to be chosen freely? But Christ himself chose freely to respond to the love of his heavenly Father. His sacrifice was part of that free response. Christ's call to us is not to place a burden on us, as the Law of Moses had been used by the Jewish leaders to place a burden on people. His call is simply to invite us to show love for others as he has shown love for us. The more we make our free response to that invitation, the more we help to ease the burden for everyone.
