ST ALBAN

Parish Newsletter – 27th March 2022 + 4th Sunday in Lent

First reading: Joshua 5:9-12

Psalm: Taste and see that the Lord is good.

Second reading: 2 Corinthians 5:17-21 Gospel: Luke 15:1-3, 11-32

Today at the 11.30 mass we are celebrating an important stage in the Church's Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. Our Catechumens, who will be Baptised at the Easter Vigil, have had their names inscribed in the Book of the Elect and our Candidates, who are completing their Christian Initiation by being Received into the Church and Confirmed at the Easter Vigil, celebrated the Rite of Election at Westminster Cathedral on the First Sunday of Lent. This began for them a Lenten period of purification and enlightenment which is marked by ceremonies called 'Scrutinies'. These are intended to prepare them to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist by uniting them more closely with Christ and by encouraging them to make progress in their efforts to love God more deeply. The theme of the Second Scrutiny, which we celebrate today, is 'Christ Our Light'.

TODAY'S READINGS:

When the Scrutinies began, in the Early Church, the readings we now use on the Fourth Sunday of Lent in Year A were chosen to be used. So today we are continuing a 2000-year-old tradition. You will find them in your Mass Books on page 172. Notice the Gospel is the account of the man born blind, from St John.

Please keep our Elect and Candidates in your prayers at this time, Frankie who will be Baptised at the Easter Vigil, Rosanna who is being Received into the Catholic Church and Luke who is to be Confirmed as well as the 8 children (whose ages range from 8 to 14)

SPIRITANS APPEAL

Next weekend, 2/3 April, we welcome Fr. Pascal Diame to all masses as he makes an appeal on behalf of the Spiritans Missionary order. They are a Roman Catholic Religious Congregation founded in 1703. Over 300 years on, 3000 professed and lay Spiritans, drawn from all continents, today carry out their mission of evangelization in more than 60 countries throughout the world. There will be a retiring collection after all masses for those who wish to assist with their work of evangelizing.
