# ST ALBAN

Parish Newsletter – 8<sup>th</sup> May 2022 + 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter

First reading: Acts 13:14, 43-52

Psalm: We are his people, the sheep of his flock.

Second reading: Apocalypse 7:9, 14-17

Gospel: John 10:27-30

#### Acts 13:14, 43-52

One of the purposes of the book of Acts was to explain to Gentile converts how their new religion started within Judaism, but soon reached beyond its roots to embrace strangers. This passage gives details about the human passions and divine providence behind that change.

#### Apocalypse 7:9, 14-17

The Revelation of John was written to help persecuted Christians to be resolute. A public document, its symbolic language is meant to seem vague and harmless to the persecutors, but full of encouragement to the believers.

## John 10:27-30

In a few short sentences, Jesus describes our relationship to him and his relationship to his Father. We're united with Jesus because we heed his word, as he is united with the Father because he does the Father's will.

#### **Priest Training Fund**

This Sunday is Good Shepherd Sunday and our second collection will support the Priest Training Fund. This fund pays for the priestly formation of men for the Catholic priesthood. There are currently 58 men studying at Allen Hall seminary, 17 of whom are from our own Diocese, and two men are studying in Rome, also from our Diocese. Last year four men who studied at Allen Hall were ordained to the priesthood to serve as our future priests. The fund also supports the ongoing enrichment and formation of our ordained priests.
