PLANNED GIVING

Thank you for your patience over the last three weekends as we presented an honest overview of the parish finances, and for your positive response in making pledges of commitment. Over the coming weeks the offers of help and assistance with various activities in the parish will be responded to. Those who have requested planned giving envelopes should have received them by now. Standing order mandates have been posted to various banks and should be activated in due course. For those who missed the opportunity to engage with the stewardship and planned giving appeal, there are still some pledge forms and volunteer forms in the porch.

Your support enables our parish to remain a living church at the centre of this community, welcoming to all and reaching out to those in need, and enables us to provide ministry to the whole parish. It also allows us to plan ahead with confidence to the future. The two projects mentioned at the start of the appeal, redecorating the church and reconfiguring the presbytery to use as a parish facility and flat for the priest may have to be delayed until substantial funds are built up.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION 2022-23

First Holy Communion Preparation for children in Year 3 and above is in 2 parts:

Part 1 is a Foundation Course for children who are Baptised Catholics and attend non-Catholic schools and for children who are not yet Baptised. This begins in September 2022. The application forms are on the parish website and in the church porch now.

Part 2 is a First Holy Communion Course for Baptised Catholic children attending Catholic schools and for children who have completed the Foundation Course. This will begin in November 2022. The forms will be available in October 2022.

Confirmation Preparation for young people in Year 9 and above. This will begin in November 2022. The forms will be available in October 2022.

THURSDAY CLUB 14TH JULY 1PM-3PM

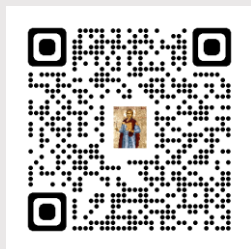

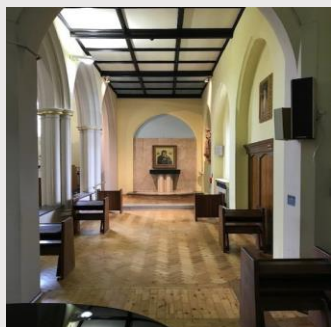
