ST ALBAN

Parish Newsletter – 27th November 2022 + 1st SUNDAY OF ADVENT

First reading: Isaiah 2:1–5

Psalm: I rejoiced when I heard them say:

'Let us go to God's house.'

Second reading: Romans 13:11–14
Gospel: Matthew 24:37–44

Advent, the beginning of our liturgical year, marks a sacred season of twofold preparation: first, we as the Church ready ourselves for the second coming of Christ; second, the Church prepares for a festive celebration of the Nativity of the Lord.

The Church community anticipates the judgement day, second coming of Christ, the day of peace. Christ came to fulfill this prophecy from Isaiah, and we pray that Christ will come to us again. We can call this theme "apocalyptic," as we look forward to the end times. In this case, the apocalypse is not a fiery, fearful future; for Christians, it is something to await in joyful hope. The Gospel for the first Sunday of Advent dives into the apocalyptic theme with warnings and pleas of preparation: "Therefore, stay awake! For you do not know on which day your Lord will come" (Mt 24:42). This is not meant to haunt or alarm but to instill in us a sense of urgency. Advent disrupts the complacency of our everyday lives, carrying ripe expectation and leaving us in anticipation.
