ST ALBAN

Parish Newsletter – 11th December 2022 + 3rd SUNDAY OF ADVENT

First reading: Isaiah 35:1–6, 10

Psalm: Come, Lord, and save us.

Second reading: James 5:7–10 Gospel: Matthew 11:2–11

The Gospel offers the perfect example of waiting in John the Baptist, whose whole life was spent in active waiting for the coming of the promised Messiah. As he languishes in Herod's prison, he hears of a different Jesus than he expected. Following the Jewish tradition, John believed the Messiah would be a powerful figure who would overthrow the Romans and establish the kingdom of God.

John sends his disciples to inquire of Jesus: "Are you the one who is to come, or should we look for another?" (Mt 11:3). Jesus quotes from the prophet Isaiah: "The blind regain their sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have the good news proclaimed to them" (Mt 11:5). These words challenge John's idea of the Messiah. Jesus says that the true reading of Scripture looks forward to a Messiah who would touch the lives of people where they are. He would heal them spiritually and physically and restore them to a relationship with God. Jesus is saying that his actions show who he is.

As Christians, we lead our lives like John the Baptist, waiting patiently while actively striving to prepare a way for Christ into our lives and into the lives of others.

PARISH MASS BOOK

If you are using the Parish Mass Book at Sunday mass during Advent, we use the Preface of Advent 1 for the first 3 Sundays and the Eucharistic Prayer for Reconciliation II (page 40).
