First reading: Isaiah 8:23–9:3

Psalm: The Lord is my light and my help.

Second reading: 1 Corinthians 1:10–13, 17

Gospel: Matthew 4:12–23

Jesus enters Galilee with the challenge: "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand" (Mt 4:17). Unambiguously, Jesus proclaims his intention to inaugurate God's kingdom. He issues a call to enter a new relationship with God by underdoing a change of heart. Jesus invites two sets of brothers, Peter and Andrew and James and John, to follow him. His call comes amid their daily occupations. They respond promptly by abandoning their ordinary activities and redirecting their lives to a new way of service to the Lord and the establishment of his kingdom.

Jesus' call comes to each of us in our everyday activities. In baptism, we are called to recognise that "the kingdom of heaven is at hand" (Mt 3:2). In our daily lives, we experience Jesus' presence and witness that we are his followers.
