Parish Newsletter – 5th February 2023 + 5th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First reading: Isaiah 58:7–10

Psalm: The good man is a light in

the darkness for the upright.

Second reading: 1 Corinthians 2:1–5 Gospel: Matthew 5:13–16

This week, our light imagery shifts a bit. We've been hearing for weeks about Gods being light for those who walk in darkness. Here, Jesus tells us that we, too can become light for others. Our participation in God's will—in enacting justice and compassion—allows us to also participate in the beauty of God. We don't create anything new here; the light is not our own. Rather, we reflect God's light out to the world, amplifying it and making it more visible. We spread God's goodness to corners it may not have reached. We see this image clearly at baptism, when a light from the paschal candle is handed to the newly baptized. We are charged with carrying Christ's light into the world wherever we go, thus giving others reason to alorify God.
