The Gospel has a familiar quotation, another of Jesus's I am statements (see Lent 3,5); today I am the way, the truth and the Life. And it is given in response to a question by Thomas, which seems to have been deliberately set up to provide a reason for giving the answer. Philip then shows a similar misunderstanding of Jesus, about the Father; and Jesus has another reason for explaining himself: if you have seen him, you have seen the Father. What the 'even greate works' are that will be performed by Jesus's followers is not clear but it could mean that miracles will continue to be worked in his name even after Jesus has gone to the Father.

Please keep in your prayers our candidates who will be Confirmed this weekend by Bishop John Sherrington.

On Saturday 13th they will celebrate a mass of thanksgiving when they will be presented with their certificates.
