To the point: This Gospel calls us to hospitality; it is about receiving others and thereby receiving Christ. But this hospitality goes beyond what we usually mean by the word. It is not about throwing parties or offering a bed when it will make us look good or give us fodder for our social media feeds. It's not a hospitality of convenience. This is rather a hospitality of the heart; it is about being willing to move around our very selves in order to make space for others. That's why Jesus's words about receiving others and offering cups of cold water are paired with those about taking up our crosses and losing our lives. This hospitality is about giving of ourselves, which is sometimes uncomfortable. But Jesus is calling us to something deeper here. We do not give up our lives for no reason, but because in doing so we imitate the self-giving love of God. By making this space for others, we find our truest selves.
