**To the point:** After several weeks of affirming the challenges of following him, Jesus offers here a word of consolation. "My yoke is easy, and my burden light" does not sound like it aligns well with all we have been hearing about persecution and suffering. But Jesus is reminding us that even though suffering might be part of the life of his followers, it is not of God and is not God's will for us—it is a side effect of living in a world where sin still has a hold. Following Jesus is in fact a joyful thing; this is the God who loves us desperately and wants nothing but our good. Jesus wants peace for us; he promises peace for us.
