"Towards October, 2024"

For the first time in the history of Christianity, a Pope is really seeking the views of the laity on how the Catholic Church should move forward. Please do join in this consultation.

In October, 2021 Pope Francis called for a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, Mission 2021 – 2024 and Westminster Diocese launched the Westminster Synodal Pathway. In November, 2021 St Alban's held our own Parish Synod with upwards of 60 parishioners taking part in a series of listening and commenting exercises. Parish Synthesis reports, including ours, were submitted to the Westminster Diocesan Gathering in early 2022 and so to the Synod of Bishops in Rome in October, 2023. "Towards October, 2024" continues the Synodal Pathway in preparation for the Second Session of the Synod of Bishops in October, 2024 and again as laity we are invited to take part. Using information provided by the Diocese there is a document "Share your thoughts" with context and 4 questions on the Parish website. If for any reason you missed the chance to participate the first time, please contribute your views now so we are really responding to the Pope's wonderful invitation.
