Jesus speaks in paradox here, reminding us that God is in the business of transcending boundaries and surpassing our expectations. He also reminds us that he is in the midst of transforming death. No more will it be a final end for humans. After Jesus completes the work of the crucifixion and resurrection, death is rather a moment of transition. It is a part of life rather than its end. Jesus himself is also a paradox here. He is, of course, troubled by the thought of dying. All humans are; it is not the fate for which God made us. But he accepts his impending death as the purpose for which he came to earth, and in his calm acknowledgment of this shows himself as something more than human as well.

Palm Sunday; please bring your own palms or branches to mass next Sunday for the traditional blessing of palms at the start of each mass. No palms will be provided. People coming to mass with branches on this day will be a great witness to the local community of our devotion going into Holy Week. It also displays care for our environment, by not importing palm branches from abroad.
