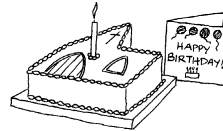

Word for Today

'They were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and began to speak foreign languages as the Spirit gave them the gift of speech.' (Acts 2:4). Pentecost recalls the birthday of the Church. People only too aware of their human weakness were strengthened by God's Spirit to be united in proclaiming the most important message of all time. And we still are today.
