- if you live in the parish, and have already had a child baptised here then make arrangements with the Parish Office for the Baptism.

For families who worship weekly at Our Lady of the Visitation,
but live outside the parish you need:

- (1) a letter of permission from the Parish Priest where you live,
- (2) a copy of the birth certificate and,
- (3) attendance at the Baptism meeting.

If you live outside the parish and do not worship here weekly, you would need to arrange the Baptism in the parish where you live.
