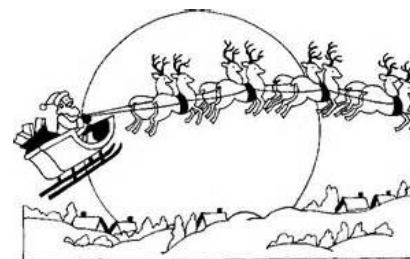
#### *YEAR of MERCY*
