Bishop Richard Moth of the Diocese of Arundel and Brighton will be the main celebrant at the concelebrated Requiem Mass on Thursday 10th November at 12.00 noon. There will be a buffet reception in the Parish Hall.

He will lie in repose at Whelan's Funeral Home, Tipperary Town. Viewing in the Funeral Home on Saturday, 12th November from 5.00 – 7.30 pm, followed by removal to St. Michael's Parish Church.

Concelebrated Funeral Mass on Sunday, 13th November at 2.00 pm, followed by burial in the local cemetery on the Cashel Road, at the end of Tipperary Town.

There will be a Memorial Mass for Seamus at 12.00 noon next Saturday, 12th November, to which everybody is invited.

On Thursday 10th November, there will be a coach leaving Greenford at 8.30 am, going to Hastings for the Funeral at 12.00 noon. The coach will leave Hastings at 4.00 pm. There will be no cost.

The dedication of the Lateran Basilica
