

ST. VINCENT PALLOTTI

St. Vincent Pallotti (1795 to 1850) was born in Rome and founded the Society of the Catholic Apostolate (The Pallottines) over 150 years ago.

He had an innate desire to do what he could to help the poor. Before he would give them a coin he would wash it in the nearby fountain.

"When I give to the poor," he would say,

"I give the coin to Christ. I want it to look nice."

In 1963 Pope John XXIII canonized Vincent Pallotti.

St. Vincent Pallotti's dream was to enable lay people to assume their proper role in the mission of the Church and to establish a community to translate his vision into reality.

The Pallottines were founded to remind the Church that the lay people are essential members and that, together with clergy and those in consecrated life, we are all sent as apostles for the Church and the World.
