Help with registration for the European Union Settlement Scheme

West London Equality Centre (WLEC) is a charity which provides free legal advice to members of the public. Due to Brexit, they are helping EU nationals and their dependants who are already living in the UK to register towards acquiring settled status under the Home Office's European Union Settlement Scheme.

It is very important that all EU nationals living in the UK register to preserve their current rights.

If you are from any EU member country (excluding Ireland) or you are the dependant or family member of someone who is from an EU member country, WLEC will assist you with your application. You can contact them on 0800-056-4745, Monday-Friday 10.00 am – 4.00 pm, to book an appointment or email them on euss@wlec.net.

They also have a drop-in session on Mondays between 10.00 am and 12.00 noon, their office is on the 4th Floor, Villiers House, New Broadway (next to Ealing Broadway station entrance), W5 2NU.
