Reflection on today's Gospel

"Who do you say I am?"

Yes: who do you say Jesus is? – this is the fundamental question of our faith. Is he a lunatic? Or a liar, or maybe just a poor, good man, maybe a visionary who was not understood by people around him, who lived 2,000 years ago and was wrongly killed and... full-stop? Or, maybe he is who he is said he is: The SON of GOD. Because if he really is who he said he is, it changes everything.

If we listen to His words they give us hope and a totally new meaning and purpose. If we believe Him, there is Heaven, and there is a space prepared for us. If we believe in Him, we are invited to a relationship with a living person, with a living God, who bridges this impossible distance between humanity and the Almighty God.

If you believe Him, your life becomes a unique journey with a clearly defined destination, and the path to this destination is to become the best version of yourself, to become holy. But this reality is not easy, in fact it is so difficult, that even the lads who were with Jesus – His closest friends, the disciples who were traveling and camping with Him for three years, couldn't fully grasp it for a while after he was gone, after He fulfilled everything what was said about Him through the centuries by all the Jewish prophets. In fact we can't comprehend this on our own. We need help, hence we pray to Jesus to reveal himself to us. We can do that because HE IS.

Whenever you go to the church and see the Priest raising a piece of bread or a chalice of wine, whenever you see a monstrance, or even the lovely box called the tabernacle with a red light or a candle next to it, you can be sure that Jesus is physically present there. He waits for you to start talking, or in fact He patiently waits for you to stop talking and thinking and just be with Him.
