COVID RESTRICTIONS / CHURCH

There is new guidance from the Church in England and Wales following the lifting of Plan B restrictions. We give some points from the Bishops' document.

We work with the tension between moving forward safely towards a more normal lifestyle while acknowledging that there is still a risk associated with gathering for sustained periods in enclosed spaces. As for any transmissible illness, anyone displaying symptoms of COVID 19 should remain at home from worship.

Those attending an act of worship may continue to wear a face mask whilst in the Church building.

Formal social distancing is no longer necessary although those present should be sensitive to the needs of others around them.

Bottles of hand sanitisers will be available for people to use as they enter and leave.

Congregational singing may continue and there is a general encouragement to wear face coverings while singing. However, it is recognised that not everyone will feel able to do so.

Here in the Visitation, we are immensely grateful to all our ushers who have made it possible to continue worshipping during the crisis. We owe them a huge debt of gratitude. We hope that they will be able to continue helping with greeting, collecting and ushering at Communion time.

We suspect that most people at the moment will feel safer and more comfortable wearing masks at the moment and we would urge everyone to consider doing so.
