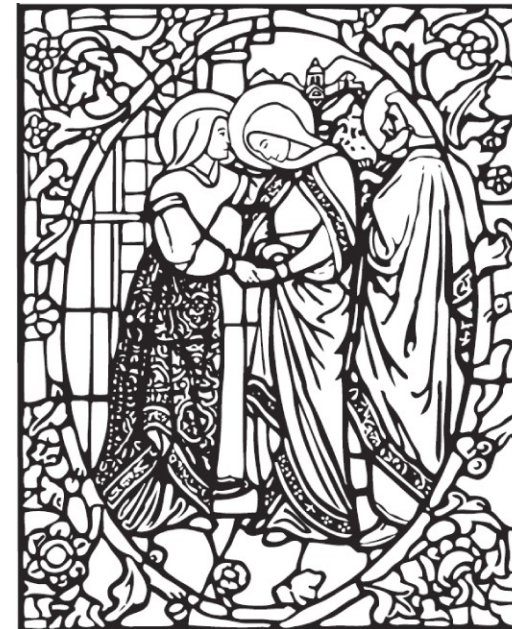

The Apostleship of the Sea***

Stella Maris, formerly known as the Apostleship of the Sea, is the official maritime charity of the Catholic Church. Its role is to support seafarers and fishers (seafarers are the ones who work on container ships). Up to 95% of goods we require in the UK come by sea. These seafarers work long hours, often for weeks or months without going ashore, far from their families, and in not very comfortable conditions. Stella Maris has over a thousand chaplains and volunteers in ports all over the world - and they are there to help when ships dock. This assistance can cover almost anything from gifts of clothes, toiletries and other essentials; phone cards so they can ring their families back home; religious resources - rosaries etc and if necessary, practical help with injuries, contractual issues and any other problems that may occur, and above all, a friendly face!

A contribution to Stella Maris will represent an expression of God's love, helping to "bring rest to the overburdened" (as in today's Gospel).
