WORD OF GOD SUNDAY Pope Francis has asked that the third Sunday in Ordinary Time each year be

observed as a special day devoted to the celebration, study and dissemination

of the word of God. He will begin this Sunday's liturgy with a solemn enthronement of the Lectionary used during all the sessions of the Second Vatican Council. This links with our Diocese's programme The God who Speaks as part of the Church's "The Year of the Word 2020". Scripture is foundational to the life of the Catholic Church and our Diocese is promoting a number of events to encourage renewed encounters with Christ in scripture. Please see the notices at the back of the church. We have ordered 100 copies of St Matthew's Gospel to hand out at Masses in Lent. These have been produced by the Bible Society. BROTHER JOHANNES MAERTENS

Brother Johannes Maertens formerly of the Mother Maria Skobtsova House in Calais is now in London helping teenage refugees. He has set up a new hospitality house—the Giuseppe Conlon House—in Haringey. Bro Johannes came to speak to the Parish Mission and Strategy meeting on 20th January. He spoke very movingly about the plight of teenage refugees from Eritrea and Sudan among other countries. He stressed how important it is for us to view refugees as people with the same need of love and care as the rest of us. Imagine your own 14 year old son/daughter having to flee war/persecution, crossing many countries, terrified, to end up alone on the streets of Northern Europe with no shelter, food or love and care. You would pray that someone like Bro Johannes would help them. Bro Johannes is coming to talk at the masses on 15 March.
