# SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER 5TH MAY 2024

### FR SHAUN'S SUNDAY THOUGHT

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus speaks to his disciples about love, emphasising the importance of remaining in his love and following his commandments. He doesn't just suggest but commands his disciples to love one another as he has loved them. This love isn't just a sentiment or emotion; it's an active, sacrificial love that seeks the well-being and salvation of others. In the context of the missionary discipleship that we are endeavouring to foster in this parish, this love isn't a passive feeling but a dynamic force that should drive our interactions and outreach efforts.

Missionary disciples are called to actively approach others with the same love and compassion that Jesus demonstrated during his ministry.

Jesus also highlights the intimate connection between himself and his disciples. He calls them friends, indicating a relationship of closeness and trust. This relationship isn't exclusive to the disciples present at that time but extends to all who believe in Jesus. Missionary discipleship, then, involves inviting others into this intimate relationship with Jesus, introducing them to the profound love and friendship that he offers.

The question of fruitfulness is also significant in the Gospel today. Jesus declares that he chose his disciples to bear fruit that will last. This fruitfulness isn't just about personal transformation but also about the spread of the Gospel. Missionary disciples are called to bear fruit in their own lives through spiritual growth and to contribute to the growth of God's kingdom by sharing the message of Jesus with others. It's a dual responsibility, both personal and communal, that forms the essence of missionary discipleship.
