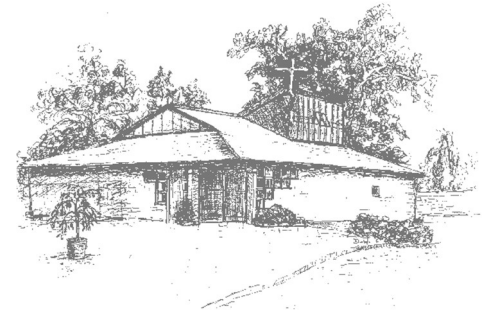

Peace Sunday this weekend

Our second collection this weekend is for Pax Christi which works for:

- "Peace - based on justice. A world where human rights are respected, basic needs are met and people feel safe and valued in their communities.
- "Reconciliation - a process which begins when people try to mend relationships - between individuals or whole countries after times of violence or dispute.
- "Nonviolence - a way of living and making choices that respects others, challenges what is not fair or just, and offers alternatives to violence and war."

Pro-life appeal next weekend

Next weekend, we shall take a second collection for SPUC which was founded in January 1967 to oppose the abortion bill being debated in parliament at the time. That bill would go on to become the 1967 Abortion Act. Tragically, more than 8.4 million unborn children have lost their lives in Britain to this Abortion Act. Abortion is the biggest killer of children in the world today.

SPUC works to protect human lives at the national and local level, and to build a society free from abortion. As well as fighting abortion, SPUC also

campaigns against other direct threats to the lives of vulnerable individuals, such as euthanasia and embryo abuse.

SPUC writes: "We recognise the need to have a consistent life ethic - to value the lives of all human beings equally - and the foundation of this must always be recognising the humanity of the child in the womb."
