Priest training fund appeal next weekend

Next weekend is Good Shepherd Sunday, the day we pray for priests and for vocations to the priesthood. The annual collection for the Priest Training Fund will also take place next weekend. This fund pays for the priestly formation of men for the Catholic priesthood.

Today, more men are training for the priesthood in the Diocese of Westminster than at any time for a decade. It costs around £100,000 to train a seminarian for the priesthood. There are currently 45 men studying at Allen Hall seminary, 28 of whom are for our own Diocese, and last year eight men were ordained to the priesthood to serve as our future priests. Your generous donation helps ensure we can support these men who are called to be like Christ the Good Shepherd.
