

14th Sunday in Ordinary Time - Year C

Dear brothers and sisters, the sending out of the disciples to places unknown to spread the Gospel is something I can relate too since I was sent here last September. Granted I didn't travel as light as the disciples did and as those of you who have seen me out and about in Hanwell know, I do salute people and even sometimes stop and have a chat. However, like the disciples I did not know what I was walking into; if I would be accepted or not; if I could carry out the mission Christ was asking of me. When we face something new, especially the unknown, it is only natural to be fearful. Faced with this fear we can turn back and cling to what we know or we can trust in the Lord who brought us this far and walk bravely onwards. I am thankful to God that I did the latter and the results have been quite remarkable. Having been among you all since September, sharing in your joys, your sorrows, your triumphs and your failures, I have come to realise that not only am I where God wants me to be but I want to be here! God has a plan for each of us but He also respects our freedom to choose, that's why he tells the disciples to dust their feet and move on when they find a house where they are not welcome: God does not force anything upon us. This is vital as Christ needs followers who are willing to devote their lives to spreading his message of joy, healing and salvation. This applies not just to priests and religious but to all baptised Catholics; we are called to be witnesses for Christ in how we live. This is no small task, as I have learnt this year, there are times we fall short but it is ok as failure is often the best teacher! In fact, a great question we can ask ourselves in the face of our failures is "*what is God trying to tell me here?*" Often it is in our failures that the Lord reveals his hand to us and we begin to understand what his will for us is. The key question is do we want to become what God wants us to be? I have been pondering this question since I was eighteen and only now, some fifteen years later can I say with confidence that I do. To God and all of you I owe a tremendous debt for helping me understand my faith and vocation in this way. No matter where I go next I will carry all of you in my heart and prayers. May God continue to bless you all. *Dan D*
