***17th October 21 - 29th Sunday In Ordinary Time - B***

Dear brothers and sisters, one of the most important services that we do in our parishes is to prepare people for the Sacrament of Baptism. Through it we become sons and daughters of God, members of his Church, disciples of Christ. When an adult wants to be baptised, he or she needs to go through the **RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults)**. The RCIA is also used to prepare Christians who were **ALREADY** baptised in other Christian Churches and now want to become Catholics. This is the journey they need to make in order to be received into Full Communion with the Catholic Church and thus be a part of it. Moreover, the RCIA is also used in order to prepare adult Catholics for their First Holy Communion and/or the Sacrament of Confirmation, if for whatever reason they did not celebrate these sacraments when they were children or teenagers.

Furthermore, the RCIA is also used to help Catholics who have stopped practicing our Faith and want to discover anew and re-start living daily our Faith.

In previous years we used the help of some of the local parishes to assist us by sharing resources. For example, the couples that needed to be prepared for the Sacrament of Marriage from Hanwell were sent either to Ealing Abbey or to Perivale parish for the Marriage preparation course. In the same way, we are now going to be doing the RCIA in partnership with Perivale parish (St. John Fisher). Part of this program will be done here, part of it will be done there. So if you know someone who fits the picture I described above, please tell them to approach me as soon as possible! **This year's RCIA has just started last week. It is NOT too late for you to join. It is happening on Mondays and Thursdays at 8 pm in Perivale at the church of St. John Fisher.**
