May the Lord bless us all the days of our life. And not just our life but the lives of our children's children. Wonderful words from this weekend's Psalm. Yet our lives are full of fears for the future, particularly the climate crisis and extinction of species.

Monday's Feast of St Francis, patron saint of the environment, gives hope, reminding us of the gentleness and respect he showed to other creatures. He thanked God for creating fresh air, clean water, nutritious food, our animal companions and the sheer beauty of the natural world.

We are among thousands of parishes celebrating the Season of Creation over the past month. But we can do more. We can join Pope Francis in engaging with the international UN climate summit in Glasgow in November, hoping for action to promote sustainable green development. Ellen Teague of the Columbans, who will be attending the summit, is speaking at Masses today and giving ideas.
