This weekend we mark two important anniversaries – Holocaust Memorial Day & Racial Justice Sunday. The first of these events memorialises the depths to which humanity can descend when we allow racism and hatred of our brothers and sisters to flourish. At the end of World War Two we committed to ensuring that such a horror would never happen again but we see something akin - albeit to a less 'industrialised' extent - being repeated in different parts of the world. The hatred of a particular group of people because of their religion and ethnicity can lead to societies thinking it is acceptable to wipe them from the face of the earth. And Racial Justice Sunday commemorations remind us that this hatred of the 'other' can start in a 'small' way – in our own hearts, our homes, our schools, our workplaces..... Thankfully, racism does not always lead to genocide, but it ruins lives by stoking fear, hatred and discrimination. As Catholics who believe that God made us all in his own image and likeness, and that we are commanded to love one another, racism is a terrible sin. This year, the Bishops have talked of the efforts made by those in the past who when they saw justice being denied to someone because of their racial origin or colour, they were prompted to act. Responding to the words of the Sermon on the Mount: "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for what is right. They shall be satisfied" such saints spent their lives working for everyone to be treated justly, with fairness and without discrimination. Maybe you could reflect if you are doing enough in your daily lives to oppose racism wherever it occurs – in so doing, you are bringing the Kingdom of God all the nearer.
