I am completely convinced that it was Our Lady & St. Joseph who inspired and moved this parishioner to make this enormous donation freeing us from this huge financial burden. On your behalf, I would like to thank this parishioner wholeheartedly for this immense gift of love. This person has an immense love for our parish of Our Lady & St. Joseph in Hanwell. May I please ask all of you to pray for this parishioner. May the Lord, through Our Lady and St. Joseph also bless all of you for your continuous financial help and support, which is always vital for our parish. God bless. Fr. Cristiano
