DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE HOLY LAND, FRIDAY MARCH 8th.

Please join us for Eucharist Adoration at 9 am followed by Mass at 10 am, to pray as a parish community for the people and the situation in the Holy Land.

If you are not able to make these times, please try to visit our Church during the day to pray for this intention. The Church is open until 7 pm. You can also, of course, pray at home.

Cardinal Vincent wrote in mid-February: "As we are all aware, the situation in the Holy Land has not improved since I last wrote, with failed negotiations, increasing humanitarian distress and a rising death toll. As Lent begins, I would like to urge that we continue our efforts, not least in prayer. And so I ask that, on Friday 8th March, there is a special focus of prayer for the Holy Land across the diocese. This could take the form of a dedicated time of prayer, perhaps before the Blessed Sacrament, for peace in the Holy Land. It could be as simple as making any regular Lenten devotions you may be having on that day for this intention. Whatever you decide, please make your parishioners aware, and encourage them to make a special effort to take part."

Let us join together in prayer on Friday 8th March remembering the words in Matthew 18, 19-20:

"In truth I tell you once again, if two of you on earth agree to ask anything at all, it will be granted to you by my Father in heaven.

For where two or three meet in my name, I am there among them."
