Dear brothers and sisters, today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, otherwise known as **CORPUS CHRISTI**. Over the last few weeks we had 4 Sunday Masses when our children made their First Holy Communion. On those days our children received for the first time our Risen Lord through this immense gift and mystery of Holy Communion. As they received the Lord in their hands and mouth, they received the whole person of Jesus Christ, his Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity. They were united to the Risen Lord in a most unique, special and profound way. The Lord came then and he comes to us today and every time we participate in the Holy Mass and receive him in Holy Communion. He comes to live in our hearts, minds, souls, bodies, feelings, thoughts, in other words, in our whole being! That's why there is an ancient phrase of the Fathers of the Church, which says, "**Receive the Body of Christ, become the Body of Christ!**" Other saints say, "**Become what you receive**". Another very famous phrase of the early Fathers of the Church says, "**The Church makes the Eucharist and the Eucharist makes the Church**". In other words, God entrusted to the Church's bishops and priests the capacity to consecrate ordinary bread and wine into the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, thus "making the Eucharist". And in turn, as we receive Holy Communion, it makes us truly become God's holy Church, His Bride, His People, His inheritance, His children. As the Second Vatican Council reminded us that "**The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life**". May we learn how to love and adore the Lord present and given to us in his Most Holy Body and Blood!

Restore Nature Now Demonstration
