Dear brothers and sisters,

In today's second reading we hear St. Paul say that the Lord told him, **"My grace is enough for you: my power is at its best in weakness"**. A few days ago, on the 3rd July, I celebrated my 20th anniversary of Ordination to the Priesthood! I would like to share my joy with you, so that together we can bless and praise the Lord for his love and faithfulness towards me but also towards all of you. So far I have spent almost half of my entire life as a priest (to be precise 9 years) serving you here in Hanwell. I spent 3 years working together with Fr. I thank the Lord with all my heart for calling me to be his son and disciple through the Sacrament of Baptism. This is our first vocation. I also thank and praise the Lord for calling me to be a minister of his Gospel, to be an instrument of his grace and salvation as a priest. After these 20 years as a priest, I can sincerely and humbly say that the grace of the Lord has truly been enough for me. His power has truly worked **in** me, transforming my own personal life and also worked **through** me, transforming the lives of thousands of people I have served in different countries around the world.
