WE MUST CONTACT OUR MPs TO VOTE AGAINST THIS BILL

Kim Leadbeater MP is introducing a bill to introduce Assisted Suicide, which will be voted on by MPs on the **29 November**. We know that assisted suicide laws in other jurisdictions have had devastating consequences for the poor, the disabled and the marginalised. This is the biggest threat to the vulnerable in a decade, and we need a huge effort to lobby MPs. Please contact your MP by visiting www.livesworthliving.org.uk. The charity Right to Life UK has a simple online mechanism to do this. It takes little more than a few minutes to input your postcode, make sure the suggested text suits your viewpoint and submit your message to ask your MP to stop assisted suicide being rushed into law.

House study/ discussion group looking at "Planetary Call to Action for Climate Change Resilience"

Following Pope Francis' letter Laudate Deum in October 2023, In May this year there was a further small document (5 pages) <https://www.mass.gov/doc/final-climate-planetary/download> produced by the Vatican's Pontifical Academy of Sciences and Pontifical Academy of Social Sciences presided over by Pope Francis.
