“FRANCIS REBUILD MY CHURCH”

One day, while praying at the church of San Damiano, St. Francis of Assisi heard Jesus Christ speak to him from the crucifix: “Francis, rebuild my Church”. At first St. Francis understood this phrase literally and went on to rebuild that church and other local churches materially using his own hands. Gradually he came to understand that the Lord was calling him to rebuild his Church in a much broader sense, through prayer, through a spirit of poverty as a counter sign to the pagan materialistic world around him and by spreading the Gospel through the evangelization. St. Francis and his religious order became one of the greatest forces of renewal in the Catholic Church up to this day!

All of us, on the other hand, have also this same call from the Lord, namely, to rebuild his Church! We do this, first of all, by our own conversion, by our own inner transformation, renouncing our sins, our old ways of living without Jesus Christ, in order to live in a completely new way in God, namely, holiness. Thus we too evangelize through our words and actions. We also rebuild the Church materially because this too is an important part of our mission. Nobody wants to be in a building which is falling apart, horrible, dirty, a mess. Everyone wants to be in a beautiful, clean and dignified environment, which invites us to pray and see the love of God for us. That's why we continue to repair our church, presbytery, hall and car parks. Today, Saturday, we finished doing further repairs in the church tower. This week we will finish repainting the car parks and repairing a broken wall there. We are also working in the Confessional room, making it in line with best practice of Safeguarding regulations. Please bear with us as all this works create some dust and noise. To conclude, the Church in every generation needs to be rebuilt! May the Lord give us much joy in this work. God bless. Fr.
