**Holy Souls:** As we all know, the month of November is dedicated to honouring the dead and relieving the sufferings of the souls in Purgatory.

A Plenary indulgence, applicable only to the souls in Purgatory, is granted to any of the faithful who (1) on one of the days from 1-8 November visits devoutly a cemetery or simply prays mentally for the dead; (2) on All Souls' Day visits a church or chapel with devotion and there recites the Our Father and the Creed.

A partial indulgence, applicable only to the souls in purgatory, is granted to any of the faithful who (1) visits devoutly a cemetery or simply prays mentally for the dead; (2) recites devoutly Lauds or Vespers of the Office of the Dead, or the invocation "Eternal rest grant to them, O Lord, ....
