
## SEVEN GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT AND SEVEN CORPORAL WORKS OF MERCY TABLEAUX

*Both tableaux have now been completed and provide the church with fitting adornment for worship and, in word and in symbol, opportunities for contemplation and reflection.*

The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit remind us that we are never left alone without the resources to meet what we need in our daily lives, and that, as St Paul puts it the Holy Spirit is where '...we live and move and have our being'.

The stained glass image of the Sacred Heart reminds us that we always receive the compassion and mercy of Christ and consequently we have the injunction upon us to show that mercy to others in the carrying out of the seven corporal works of mercy.

Pope Francis has said, 'The month of June is traditionally dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the greatest expression of divine love ... Popular piety highly values symbols, and the Sacred Heart of Jesus is the ultimate symbol of God's mercy. But it is not an imaginary symbol; it is a real symbol which represents the centre, the source from which flowed salvation for all humanity'.
