




"November Dead List"

Throughout November the Church encourages us to pray for the departed and to offer the Sacrifice of the Mass for them. To assist the faithful in their wish to pray for their deceased relations and friends many parishes invite parishioners to place the names of their deceased loved ones in an envelope so that Mass can be offered for them. That Mass here in St Paul's will be offered on Wednesday 30th November 2022. If parishioners wish to have Masses offered individually for the deceased please book such Masses in the normal way.

Often it is suggested that an offering also be placed in the envelope. The names in these envelopes constitute what is commonly known as the "November Dead List". "November Dead List". These envelopes are available in the church entrance.
