A Note on Fiducia Supplicans

The Declaration *Fiducia Supplicans* presents a rich and broad reflection on the meaning of blessings and then examines in a careful and nuanced way the possibility of blessing couples in irregular situations including same-sex couples. The Declaration is written as a response to questions which the Dicastery has received about such blessings and the recent *dubia*.

Fiducia Supplicans opens with the words, "The supplicating trust of the faithful People of God receives the gift of blessing that flows from the Heart of Christ through his Church." (n.1) All blessings come from God through the Church.

This Declaration affirms the Church's perennial teaching on marriage and states that blessings of people in complex situations does not validate their status or change in anyway the Church's teaching (n.4-6). These blessings are acts of devotion which are outside of the Eucharist and sacramental practice (n.24). Pastoral practice should neither cause confusion nor scandal, and so "blessing should never be imparted in concurrence with the ceremonies of a civil union, and not even in connection with them. Nor can it be performed with any clothing, gestures, or words that are proper to a wedding. The same applies when the blessing is requested by a same-sex couple." (n.39)
